

Food Waste Collection

Say Hello to Alicante's Food Waste Bin! It's located in the P1 trash room, adjacent to the recycling dumpsters.

Separating food waste from trash put down the chute supports California's environmental goals, and can lead to reduced trash collection fees for the Association.



Per California law, starting in 2022 residents are asked to deposit their food waste in the bin.

See below guidance for items to put in the Food Waste Bin. Residents may want to purchase a container to gather their food waste: Ace, Target, etc. Examples: <u>here</u>. Note: Compostable bags are <u>not</u> allowed: Materials must be "LOOSE," so driver can see there's no contamination.



Yes, put these in the Food Waste Bin!

- All fruits
- All vegetables
- All pastas, grains, rice, and beans
- All cooked meat, poultry, seafood, shellfish, bones, eggs, and egg shells
- All bread, coffee grounds & filters, cheese and pastries
- Parchment paper, kitchen paper towels, and soiled napkins



No, don't put these in the Food Waste Bin!

- Oil and grease
- Plastic containers, bags, film & gloves
- Raw meat
- Cans and glass
- Packaging cardboard
- Paper and biodegradable plates, cups, and utensils
